MUSKEGON BOAT TROLLING TOURNAMENT SET FOR MAY 20

May finds the boat trollers towing to Muskegon for Our 2nd annual outing there. Let's hope we have a repeat of last year's weather conditions. Nothing like calm seas. Last year's weigh-in found a mixed bag of all the species. So go equipped for anyone of them. Spoons dominated last year, mostly black and raspberry. The fish should be holding about 30 - 60 feet straight out from the pier heads. Caution anyone leaving out of Harbortown Marina. Stay on center leaving the marina and heading out into Muskegon Lake. Very shallow on both sides.

As of this writing, we're not sure of where and when the Captain's meeting and weigh-in will be due to low water levels. But all will be notified well in advance of the tournament as to the location, especially Larry. If you can't attend the April membership meeting, be sure and contact Doug Karakas at 545-1181 just prior to the tournament for details.

So remember to check the wheel lugs and buddy bearings and see you at the docks.
