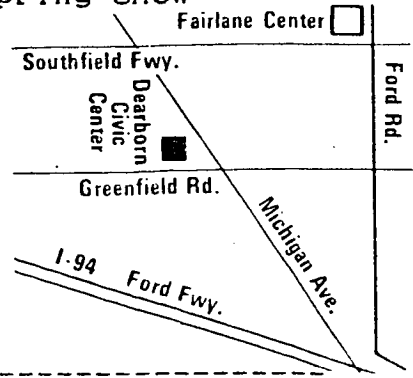

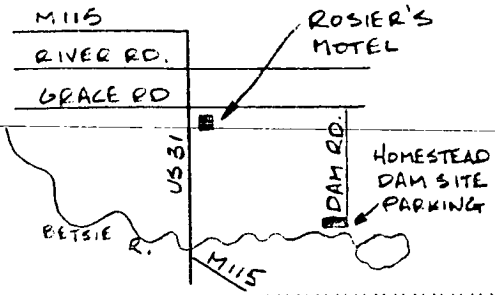
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 TIPPY DAM "SUPER" TOURNAMENT (WATA)

The Wellston Area Tourist Association puts on this tournament. Two divisions: boat and bank. Trophies will be given for the three largest male steelhead and the three largest female steelhead in each division. A revolving trophy will be given to the Chapter with the largest total number of pounds and an individual trophy for the largest total number of pounds. Boundries are Tippy Dam to M-55. Time: daylight until 5:00 p.m. All fish must be weighed-in by 5:30 p.m. at Fisherman's Headquarter's. \$6.00 entry fee: \$2.00 for trophies - \$4.00 applied to meal at participating restuarants. Presentations begin at 8:00 p.m. at the Deer Horn Inn. Registration will be at Fisherman's Headquarter's.

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1986 BOAT TROLLING TOURNAMENTS

Its almost time, once again, for the boat trolling season to begin. This year's schedule is below. The entry fee remains \$25.00 for each tournament or \$125.00 for the annual fee, which will allow you to fish all eight (8) contests. No major rule changes have been made for this year. However, an interesting concept will be tried out at the first tournament at Benton Harbor. Saturday's event will be a normal one day tournament while on Sunday, based on Saturday's standing, the first place boat will be paired as a team with the last place boat, the second place boat with the second from last, etc. Using normal tourney rules, the top five placing teams will receive trophies (one per boat). This will be independent of Saturday's fishing-- the idea is "teaching for trophies". For further info. see Ted Warrow at the membership meetings or contact him at 427-1353 (eves.)

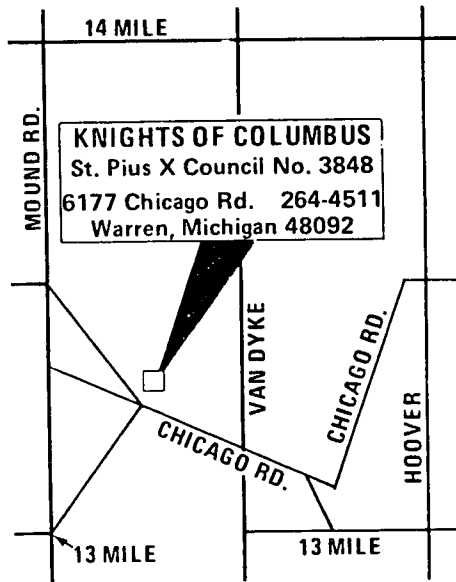
