Mated with the Sheffield S1002 reel, All you'll need to add is a river.

Trolling Schedule Set for 2020 Season

A group of DAS captains got together on November 7 to plan the 2020 trolling tournament schedule. In attendance were Jim Zanke, Brad Walton, Dan Chisholm, Ken Cione, Fred Chartier, and Bob Feisel. We will be having 7 trolling tournaments next year. Our season starts May 2 at the southern Lake Michigan port of St Joseph where we hope to find those feisty spring King salmon that fight all the way to the net. Then we move to a 2-day tournament at Grand Haven on May 16-17. The 2-day format is always interesting because a leading position on day 1 can be a challenge to defend on day 2. We will be at the great port of Manistee twice this year, on May 30 and on August 22. And the ports of Harbor Beach, Erieau, and Ludington fill out the rest of the schedule. At Erieau we will be including walleye in the scoring. The cost to enter a DAS trolling tournament is ONLY \$20 per boat, and the entry fee includes food and beverages at the weigh-in for all participants. At all of the tournaments the optional Big Fish bet will be \$20. We hope that there will be a lot of DAS boats participating in the trolling tournaments next year, enjoying the friendly competition and camaraderie. The DAS anglers also did well against the Metro West Steelheaders, who mostly fished the surf. The Metro West club didn't weigh any fish. So it will be another year
