Entry fee is \$15 per person (Captain, crew, plus guests that will be joining us for lunch at the weighin). Fees will be collected at the weigh-in.

The optional Big Fish bet is \$20 per boat. Prize money is split 50% for biggest Salmon, 25% for biggest Steelhead, and 25% for biggest Lake Trout.

Captains are requested to register at least 3 days before the tournament. Late registrations will be accepted, but it might not be possible to include lunch at the weigh-in. DAS Assists DNR With Salmon-in-the-Classroom Delivery

On Friday, November 18, 2022 DAS members will assist DNR Aquatic Education Coordinator, Tracy Page in distribution of salmon eggs to approved/qualified schools in Southeastern Michigan. The distribution takes place at the Metropolitan Beach Nature Center Pickup will begin at 10am. This year qualified schools get the 150 eggs in a bag, food, a Chinook sticker and a poster. So extra swag! Pickup ends at 4pm. At 2:30 the workshop ends and those teachers are invited over to the Fisheries Research Station for a tour.

On Thursday November 3rd, the captains met to determine the 2023 Trolling Schedule and rule changes. Those not familiar with the meeting, any captain that participated in a 2022 trolling event is invited to determine trolling ports and dates for the following year. We also discus rule changes. It was decided to raise the entry fee from **\$20 per boat to \$15 per person**. This change is to help reduce the Club's costs for the tournaments due to rising food costs. It was thought this was fair because of the variation of participants. Anywhere from 2 to 6 people occupy a boat.

I want to thank all the captains that volunteered to be Port Captain! Their duties include roll call, fish call, collecting for big fish, and most importantly – supplying lunch. For all of those that enjoyed a nice hot meal after coming off the water, I would like to add some comments. It is very important to register early! Whether the port captain is working with a caterer or preparing the food himself, it's critical to get an early and accurate count. Even ordering pizzas for a group this large requires a couple of days' notice. We always want to make sure there is enough food for everyone, with little waste. This also helps to keep the costs of the tournament down. So, when you fill out registration form, please include any non-fishing people that may join us for lunch - wives, grandchildren, etc. in the "Number of persons for lunch". Bob Ksionzek has made this incredibly easy with the form available on the Steelheader's web site! The ports, dates, and port captains can be located on the DAS Message Board and on page 5 of this newsletter. Please join us and register early.

DAS Annual Dues

There has been some confusion lately regarding the DAS annual membership dues. Here are some guidelines to help sort this out:

- Regular (no discounts) annual membership dues: \$35 on your anniversary date.
- Seniors 65+: \$20 on your anniversary date.
- Event membership (this one has caused some confusion): A <u>NEW</u> member may join DAS during any of our sanctioned events for \$20. At the new members anniversary date, the age appropriate rate applies. \$35 for regular, \$20 for senior.
- Youth are granted free membership up until 16 YOA where the regular rate would then apply. Youth members are required to pay for any outing they attend.
- DAS Board of Directors membership are free while they serve on the BOD.
