

*****The June 8 tournament at Harbor Beach is on a Sunday. Harbor Beach is having a Veterans Fishing event on Saturday, June 7. DAS captains are welcome and encouraged to participate in the Veterans Fishing event (participation is optional). Participants can receive a free boat slip for Friday night. Take a Veteran fishing!**

A Skipper's best 4 tournament scores will count towards the Skipper of the Year Award. The entry fee will be \$15 per person. The optional Big Fish bet remains at \$20 / boat and is divided into 3 separate pools: Big Salmon for \$10 per boat, Big Steelhead for \$5 per boat, and Big Lake Trout for \$5 per boat. All 3 pools must be entered to participate. Tournament entry fees and Big Fish bets will be collected at the weigh-in and lunch will be provided at the weigh-in. There are no Skipper's meetings prior to the tournament. Skippers should register at least 3 days prior to the tournament.

This salmon salad is very quick to make with canned pink salmon, green onions, celery, mayonnaise, lemon juice, and dill. Delicious on a bed of lettuce, on an avocado half, or eaten as a sandwich on focaccia bread.

Prep Time: 5 minutes Total Time: 5 Minutes

Ingredients:

- 2 (6 ounce) cans pink salmon, drained
- ½ cup finely sliced green onions
- ½ cup finely chopped celery
- ¼ cup mayonnaise
- ¾ teaspoon lemon juice
- ¾ teaspoon dried dill or to taste
- ¾ teaspoon seasoned salt or to taste



Directions:

1. Combine salmon, green onions, celery, mayonnaise, and lemon juice in a bowl until well combined; season with dill and salt to taste.
