

On Sunday September 7, the Detroit Area Steelheaders held the final SOTY Outing in Frankfort on Lake Michigan 🤏 🔀 A few days prior to and the actual day of the outing which was originally set to Saturday September 6, Lake Michigan was pretty angry not allowing anyone to fish on her waters. There were strong gale force winds with winds projected anywhere from 15 to 30mph and gusts up to 40mph within those 3 days and waves up to 10ft or more. Due to weather conditions the outing for the 6th was rescheduled to the 7th. The winds were forecasted to calm down to about 2 to 4 footers. On Sunday September 7, 4 brave Captains and their crews set out for Lake Michigan in hopes that the waters had calmed down and some fish could be found. The ride into the lake was guite bumpy with waves at 3ft to 4ft, lines were set at 7am. The lake was desolate with just the few boats unlike the weekend before with crowds of boats searching for salmon that were making their way towards Betsie Lake and into the Betsie River. Boats went straight our and dished back and forth between the piers, one went way out straight from the piers into deeper and colder water, and yet one went south towards the Herring Hole. The water temperature was the same throughout the lake and finding salmon made it tough. As the day progressed the waves were building more like 4ft to 6ft. Some Captains and Crew members were having a tough time with the waves and causing some sea sickness. Lines were pulled at 12pm and the weigh-in with lunch was held at the Frankfort Municipal Marina at 1pm. 1st place went to Wonder with 52.60lbs, 2nd place went to Moonshot with 15.45lbs, and 3rd place went to Vicki's Seacret with 13.65lbs. Big Steelhead went to Moonshot with 8.10lbs, and Big King went to Vicki's Seacret with 13.65lbs. A big thank you to Bob Fiesel for hosting the outing and providing a wonderful lunch of fried chicken, potato salad, coleslaw, blackberry pie and an assortment of cookies. Thank you to all Captains and Crew members for participating in doing what we all love to do best. See you all next season in the spring to continue our SOTY Outings. FISH ON
