**Please note that if information is not received we may not have a gift for your child. I will send back a confirmation email once received. If you do not receive an email back, please note I did not receive original RSVP.





Fishing started at 6am, the early mornig was dark, cold, and clear skies with temperatures in the 30s. The wind came from the south east and very light barely causing a a surf out on the open water. 14 DAS members fished the outing and about half of that were Metro-West Steelheaders. Most DAS members were on the pier, while a few were on the beach and Tippy Dam. Metro-West members all fished the beach. The light wind and direction made fishing tough and pushed the fish away from the shoreline and pier. It was a tough early morning not one bite, but eventually a rod went down and Kevin Longley was running down the pier for his rod. Finally a steelhead was reeled in and laying on the pier. Smoked Salmon Eggs Benedict With Lemon Dill Hollandaise could be just the pescatarian recipe you've been looking for. One serving contains 540 calories, 41g of protein, and 33g of fat. This recipe serves 2 and costs \$6.33 per serving. Head to the store and pick up eggs, lemon, butter, and a few other things to make it today. It is brought to you by Foodista. From preparation to the plate, this recipe takes around 45 minutes.

Ingredients

- 1 cup baby arugula, 1 cup baby spinach, 2 tablespoons butter, 3 large egg yolks, 4 eggs,
- 1 tablespoon dill, 1 lemon, 2 slices multigrain bread, 2 servings salt and pepper, 8 ounces salmon,
- 2 tablespoons water, 1 tsp worcestershire sauce.
- 1. Make Lemon Dill Hollandaise: Fill a medium saucepan about halfway with water, and bring to a gentle simmer over medium heat.
- 2. Put the egg yolks and water in a heatproof bowl, season with a pinch of dill (if using dried), salt, and pepper.
- 3. Whisk the ingredients together and then place the bowl on top of the saucepan. Keep stirring the egg mixture for about 5 minutes or until it begins to thicken. Make sure you dont scramble your eggs! Once the eggs are thickened, take the bowl off the water and set aside. Poach the eggs: Fill a medium saucepan with water, add a splash of white vinegar (optional, but this helps hold the whites together which results in nicely shaped eggs) and bring to a gentle simmer. You want tiny bubbles only, not a rolling boil. Gently add eggs to water and poach until deisred doneness. Meanwhile, toast bread.
- 4. Place toast on plates and top with arugula, spinach and salmon.
- 5. Place eggs on top of salmon and spoon hollandaise over the top.
- 6. Garnish with dill, salt and freshly cracked black pepper and serve.
