"Wind at Your Back, Don't Cross the Crack"

Blaise shared his experience fishing Saginaw Bay for Walleye and included well needed safety information that could save a life. The check-list that he passed out urged attendees to have items like a GPS, cell phone, compass, flares, ice picks, safety rope, well, you get the picture—"be prepared".

After a well prepared safety prep he included good information on fishing the Bay. Little Cleo's, Jig Raps, and Doo Jiggers (all of the blue and silver variety) were his baits of choice. Jigging, dead sticking, tip downs, and pretty much anything you use to get your offering down to the Walleye were demonstrated.

## Pg 3 Plan a Free Fishing Weekend Feb. 15-16 and June 7-8

The State of Michigan allows free fishing twice a year in 2025. The dates are Feb 15-16 and June 7-8.

On those weekends, residents and nonresidents can fish on both inland and Great Lakes waters for all species of fish without a fishing license. All fishing regulations, including bag limits, size limits and species restrictions, remain in effect. A Recreation Passport will not be required for entry into state parks and boating access sites during free fishing weekends.

If fishing the February weekend remember "no ice is safe ice". A strong ice safety message is recommended to be stressed at every outing. The DNR does not monitor ice conditions, but local bait shops and fishing clubs may have current information.

The DAS will hold our third AOTY event in Saginaw Bay on Saturday, February 15, 2025.

Ice safety tips can be located on the Michigan DNR web site. Search "ice safety information".

#### **AOTY Outing Saginaw Bay and River February 15, 2025**

Date: Saturday, February 15, 2025

Location: Saginaw Bay State Park, 3582 State Park Rd, Bay City, MI. and downtown Saginaw Bay River. Please note, the Saginaw Bay <u>AND</u> River can be treacherous and conditions change rapidly. Take caution because "no ice is safe ice".

Target Fish: Best five Walleye by weight with length of longest fish as tie-breaker.

Time: Start 0700 to Pull lines at 1300 (7 am to 1 pm).

Weigh-in: 1400 (2 pm) at one of the State Park Pavilions. Shore lunch follows weigh-in.

Bait Shop: Riverview Party Store, 3885 Kawkawlin River Dr., Kawkawlin.

Registration form is located on the DAS website in the AOTY tab. Or text Kevin Longley 248-240-

7576 by Thursday, February 13 so he has an accurate count for the food order.

Your membership status must be up-to-date prior to registration.

Event registration includes a shore lunch for \$15. Optional Big Fish registration \$10. When you register you are considered "in" big fish unless you clearly "opt out" of big fish.

Total cost \$25.

Big Fish: There is a big fish payout to the three heaviest Walleye. First big fish is awarded 50% of the total pool, second big fish 30% and third big fish 20% payout. Walleye minimum size on the Bay 13". As this event takes place on the Saginaw Bay and on the Saginaw River please show up for the weigh

-in regardless of catch so we know everyone is accounted for.

At the very least, text Kevin or WhatsAp that you are off the fishing grounds and will not be attending the weigh-in.

# Change of Pace Lemon-Herb Baked Cod

#### **Lemon-Herb Baked Cod**

#### Ingredients:

4 cod fillets (about 6 ounces each)

2 lemons, thinly sliced

2 tablespoons olive oil

1 tablespoon dried oregano

1 teaspoon dried thyme

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

1/4 teaspoon red pepper flakes (optional)

Salt and pepper to taste

Fresh parsley, for garnish
