## May 27, 2025 Membership Meeting

Bob Michell shared a wealth of information during our May Membership meeting. He started with a bit of a history lesson as he walked us through 29 years of his Detroit Steelheaders experience. Recalling the period where DAS would have 58 boats registered for our tournaments. Remembering the earlier days of weekend anglers working through the Treaty established between the SOM-Federal Government and the Michigan Indian Tribes. Reminiscing on the Lake Huron silver fish crash. Then he got serious about fishing.

How did he learn to become consistent enough on a day-to-day basis that he was a force during any competition and a successful charter boat captain? What became apparent was his focus on information gathering was the foundation for success. He would observe others and ask them two important questions. What did you do, and why did you do that. Building up that data base while at the same time networking and observing weather patterns before you leave home made a huge difference between fishing and catching. It also helped to have a plan "A" and a plan "B". If "A" stops working, go to plan "B".

#### **NEXT AOTY OUTING RELOCATED & DATE CHANGED**

The next AOTY Outing will be held in Port Austin and the date has been changed to July 13, 2025. The walleye fishing should be in full swing here and it's an easier one day trip if you choose.

You can start fishing at 7:00 am. You must pull lines by 1:00 pm. Coolers MUST BE IN LINE BY 2:00 pm.

Weigh-In and Lunch will be at Veteran's Waterfront Park Pavillion adjacent to the west of the DNR Boat Launch

To enter simply TEXT me, Bob Ksionzek at (586)531-9198 by 6:00 pm. Thursday July 17, 2025 so we can get a finalized count for lunch. For boat entry: Include the captain's name and phone number first, followed by all other anglers' names (first and last) on board.

Entry fees are \$15.00 per person, which includes lunch. Big fish pool is an additional \$10.00. You may opt out of big fish if you choose but everyone on board will either be IN or opt OUT. Let me know in your entry text if you are opting out or you will be considered IN and required to pay the big fish pool fee.

This is an individual event for AOTY (Angler Of The Year).

YOU MUST KEEP EACH PERSON'S FISH SEPERATE AND IDENTIFIED.

DNR minimum size rule for this area is 13". (MH-4 See 2025 Michigan Fishing Regulations). The limit is 8 fish per person, but we will count your best 5 fish by weight plus 5 points per fish. Any ties will be determined by length of fish.

Most fishing at this time of the year is around the reefs 3 - 4 miles west of Port Austin in 35-40 FOW. Look at your charts on your graphs and get familiar with them. Depths can change suddenly close to the reefs, so just be aware. There can also be some good fishing due north of the harbor around the reef near the Lighthouse. CAUTION: If you are not familiar with this area, NEVER go between the Lighthouse and land. There is some very shallow water here and a hard rocky bottom. Very Dangerous for most boats.

Techniques include using crawler harnesses off down riggers 15'-25' down or 3 and 4 colors of lead core. Hot n' Tots and other body baits can work as well for some of the larger walleye.

#### Harbor Beach 6/8/25

Eight of our Captains brought their boats and crews to this year's tournament. All eight also participated in the Veterans outing on Saturday, so the idea to lump both of these events together on the same weekend worked out. The Thumb Steelheaders do a great job organizing this outing to honor our Vets. Also on Friday, Brad, (Moonshot), invited all the Captains and their crews to ribs and pulled pork. Everyone brought side dishes and desert to share. Thankyou Brad and Julie. Those were some of the best ribs I've ever had.

Fred, (Lake Buzzard), and I brought our boats up on Wednesday and shared a VRBO for the long weekend. We planned to arrive on Tuesday but strong winds out of the south made us delay one day. Wednesday, the winds out of the north prevented us from going out. Thursday thru Sunday the winds were mild out of the north/northeast.

Fred and I had talked about going out to the reefs in the middle of the lake and with calm seas on Thursday we went out on his boat. Friday we both took our boats out to the reef with respective crews. Let me say, the fishing out on the reefs is fantastic. We boated one over 17 lbs., and Fred boated one over 18 lbs. Our hog came on a Thin Fin on a flat line right on the surface. I've fished Lake Superior for many years and you can catch some trophy fish there, but I've never had a box of Lake Trout that averaged this size.

Overall, reports were that the fishing had been tough in this area recently. For the Vets outing, we fished in 83 to 96 fow a few miles north of Port Hope. We ended up with five Lake Trout and one Steelhead. Based on reports from our other Captains, this would have been a winning catch if it would have been our club tournament. So for Sunday, we set up in the same spot, (almost). We couldn't get to our waypoint because Moonshot was already sitting on it. The nine o'clock fish call confirmed that the fishing was tough. Two boats hadn't boxed a fish, two had one each, two had two each, Moonshot, (on my spot), had four, and Wonder was in the lead with five. At the eleven o'clock fish call, some of the skippers added to their total with Wonder out in front with seven total, and Moonshot, (on my spot), with four.

At the weigh-in, our lunch included broasted chicken, red skin potatoes and, coleslaw, and potato salad provided by Ricky J's.

Lake Buzzard took first place with a total of 65 pts., Wonder in second with 55.35 pts. And Moonshot, (on my spot), third with 46.5 pts. All boats caught fish. Lake Buzzard won \$45 for a 10.95 lb. Lake Trout, Wonder \$45 for big Steelhead, and Moonshot, (on my spot), won \$90 for the biggest and only salmon caught, a 2.70 lb. Coho.

Overall I think in spite of a couple of lost props, a blown transmission, a motor not wanting to pee, and me losing a 20 lb. cannon ball, all had a great weekend. I wouldn't be surprised if the Skippers decide to link up our tournament on the same weekend as the Vets outing again next year.

**Change of Pace: Easy Crab and Shrimp Bisgue** 

## EASY CRAB AND SHRIMP BISQUE

#### **Ingredients:**

Crab meat, shrimp, olive oil, red pepper, onion, garlic, tomato sauce, Old Bay, hot sauce half-and-half, Parmesan cheese, chives or parsley, salt and pepper.

#### Instructions:

**First, prepare your crab and shrimp.** Gently pick through the crab meat to remove any shells. Remove the tails and legs from the shrimp and devein them.

**Then, cook your vegetables.** Heat olive oil in a large saucepan over medium high heat. Add the onion and red pepper and cook for 5-7 minutes, until softened. Then add in the garlic and cook for another minute.

**Next, stir in the tomato sauce, hot sauce, Old Bay, half-and-half and salt and pepper.** Stir until combined, then add in the crab and shrimp. Bring to a boil, then reduce to a simmer.

**Then, transfer the mixture to a blender or food processor.** (Optionally, remove some shrimp and crab to garnish the bowl with). Puree until smooth.

**Finally, plate and garnish the soup.** Pour soup into bowls and sprinkle Parmesan cheese and chives or parsley on top. If you reserved shrimp and crab, place them in the center of the bowl. You can also drizzle the soup with more half-and-half, if desired.
