Season in Review, and The Value of DAS by valued lifetime member Mark Williams. Thank you Mark you have helped the DAS in many ways.

As the calendar changes to September, I have only three trips left before the boat will be pulled on Sept.23. Our Big Lake season can be summed in in one word.... AMAZING! It has literally been the best season for quality kings and numbers that I have ever seen in my 20 years of running Silver Addiction. Proof of this is the horrible fish cleaning station problems seen up and down the coast where they use barrels to contain the carcasses, as they were overwhelmed with the volume of fish being caught by everyone.

With all of this excellent fishing I started to think of all the great days on the water, and I concluded why I was being so successful. Yes, the fish were biting on a day-to-day basis, but there was a particularly important part of our program that stood out. It was my mate Bo, and what he and I did together, to make Silver Addiction perform at a high level. Always communicating, questioning, and fine tuning the program to keep the bite going. I then realized that while this was being done between us, what got me to this point was everyone that I learned from along the way. In my family, it was my Father, Grandpa, and Uncles that taught me how to fish, but when it came to the great lakes and salmon fishing it was the members of the DAS that help show me the new way to fish. Yes, I chartered with my father, but that was during the hay day when you only need five riggers to catch a box full.

When I started on my own it was joining the DAS that had the greatest influence in making me a better great lakes angler. Rob Pinskey told me about the club and invited me to a meeting. I met Blaise Pewinski through Rob and they taught me how to fish Lake Trout at Port Austin. Blaise actually gave me the "How to Catch Lake Trout Bible" at a Special People outing, sharing his proven tips and tricks, which to this day still helps me put fish in the boat, but more importantly, he has become one of my best friends. DAS also found me my "Fishing Father" Dick Shirk, who my wife Sandi and I met while on our way to a meeting at Gander Mountain, looking at the wall of spoons and trying to decide which five spoons we would buy with the \$20 dollars we had to spend. Dick gave us his "two cents worth" of advice and invited us to the meeting, and as they say the rest is history. I have had the privilege to fish with these men and have met and fished with many other DAS members, Dave Even, Bob Mitchell, and Jim Karr, just to name a few. Change of Pace

Baked Walleye: Thanks to Rob Pinskey for this Recipe.

Line a cake pan with tin foil (be careful not to poke any holes).

Spray the foil lightly with Pam.

Lay walleye filets in pan packed fairly tight together single layer (approx. 1 1/2lbs. For a 9"x 9" pan, approx. 2+ lbs. for a 9"x 13" pan).

Melt 2 Tablespoons of butter and 1 teaspoon of lemon juice and brush on fish.

Add your favorite seasonings on top.

Then Spread an 8 oz. Bag of Kroger Pizza blend shredded cheese (9"x9" pan). (One and 1/2 bags for a 9"x 13" pan). (Mozzarella works well too).

Sprinkle a handful of Italian bread crumbs lightly over the top.

Bake at 400* for 20 minutes, check if cheese has browned properly.
