What they do is facilitate the coordination of communication between the people, the fish, the eco system, and the waterways within the State of Michigan. The information they uncover through Great Lakes surveys, long term monitoring, habitat surveys, and research projects is passed along to other groups who use the information to manage the overall health of the fisheries. Brad's slide presentation covered the health of various fish species and how they gather the information that is shared with other groups who are responsible for keeping the fishery healthy for future generations. In short, it was a great meeting.

PG 3 AOTY Outing Saginaw Bay and River February 15, 2025

Detroit Area Steelheaders Saginaw Bay/River walleye outing was held Feb 15th. We left out of Bay City State Park as a group (10 anglers) traveling on a 4 wheeler with 2 anglers on a sled being pulled behind it, a side-by-side, a snow dog, and a snowmobile. The ice was good but there were a few pressure cracks to get over. We proceeded with caution out about 5 miles and set up to fish. Fishing was slow, as the walleye were tight lipped. Finally about 8:30 a fish was caught! A few more were caught throughout the morning for a total of 5. There was a light snow that began to pick up and conditions were deteriorating quickly with a storm coming in. We decided to pull lines a bit early to get back in safely. By this time we could not see land and visibility was reduced. Kevin led the way on his snowmobile with his chart plotter in the near white out conditions (a must have out there for just this reason). The snow dog was dogging out but we were able to get it moving. We were almost to land when the side by side got stuck in a pressure crack but we were able to push it out in short time and were back on our way to shore. 3 anglers fished the river. Fishing was slow there too. Try as they may only 1 undersized fish was caught. After the weigh in we went to a local establishment to get together, warm up, and have a meal.

Results:

Kevin Longley caught 2 fish and placed 1st. He also had the biggest fish, weighing in at 4.63lbs Karen Longley caught 1 fish for 2nd place and had 2nd biggest fish, weighing 3.72lbs Mike Paradise caught 1 fish for 3rd place and had the 3rd biggest fish at 1.82lbs Bob Paradise rounded up the pack for 4th place with 1 fish

Saginaw Bay conditions can turn quickly and anything can happen. Detroit Steelheaders stuck together and helped each other out and that's what it's all about!

The DAS outing is Saturday, March 22. Starting time is 6am till 3pm. Weigh in at 4pm at the Manistee River Lodge 918 Seaman rd. Wellston Mi. The limit for steelhead on the Manistee River for this outing is one fish, therefore the winner will be determined by the weight of your fish. Dinner will also be at the Lodge. If you need a cabin, call 231-848-4844, ask for Chelsea. Tell her you are fishing with Roger from the Detroit Area Steelheaders and they will give you a good rate. They fill up this time of the year so you should call soon. We will have a voluntary \$10 big fish contest that pays 3 places, 50% pay out for 1st big fish, 30% payout for 2nd big fish and 20% for 3rd big fish. Registration for the outing and shore lunch is \$15/person plus the \$10 big fish pool. You must opt "out" of the big fish pool before the start of the outing or you are automatically "in" big fish pool. You can fish anywhere in the Manistee river watershed (Bear Creek, Manistee lake, Big Manistee river, pier, or beach, in Manistee. Hope to see a lot of the new guys and girls there and if you need more information or any kind of help you can contact Roger Paradise at (586 354 1121) or Bob Paradise at (586 457 4073). Register for the outing through the DAS website under the AOTY tab or text Roger 586-354-1121 your intent to join the outing. Indicate the outing date, location, your name, phone number and in/out of big fish pool. Because Roger needs to know how many people will be eating the shore lunch, Roger needs to know how many will attend. Register by 4 pm Thursday, March 20.

DAS captains are welcome and encouraged to participate in the Veterans Fishing event (participation is optional). Participants can receive a free boat slip for Friday night. Take a Veteran fishing!

A Skipper's best 4 tournament scores will count towards the Skipper of the Year Award. The entry fee will be \$15 per person. The optional Big Fish bet remains at \$20 / boat and is divided into 3 separate pools: Big Salmon for \$10 per boat, Big Steelhead for \$5 per boat, and Big Lake Trout for \$5 per boat. All 3 pools must be entered to participate. Tournament entry fees and Big Fish bets will be collected at the weigh-in and lunch will be provided at the weigh-in. There are no Skipper's meetings prior to the tournament. Skippers should register at least 3 days prior to he tournament.

Change of Pace: A Fish Hater's Guide to Salmon

Prep Time – 2 minutes. Cook Time – 15 minutes. Total Time – 17 minutes. Author - Talia Kornfeld

Ingredients:

Salmon:

- 3 or 4 6 oz Salmon Filets
- Salt and Pepper

Glaze:

- 3 tbsp Dijon Mustard
- 3 tbsp Brown Sugar
- 1 tbsp Maple Syrup
- 1 tbsp Soy Sauce
- 1 tsp Rice Vinegar

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 425 degrees.

Line a baking sheet with parchment paper or foil. If using foil, use cooking spray.

Generously season both sides of the salmon filets with salt and pepper.

Place the filets on the prepared baking sheet and bake for 12 minutes.

While the salmon is cooking, make the sauce. Combine all sauce ingredients in a small saucepan over medium heat and bring to a boil. Stir, and set aside.

Remove the cooked salmon from the oven and switch the oven to broil. Using a basting brush, cover every inch of the salmon in the glaze. Don't skip the sides!

Return to the oven and broil for 3 minutes.

I like to serve this with a creamy polenta and steamed broccoli.
