The kitten must be kept on a high-protein kitten diet for at least 12 months. The breeder recommends Purina Pro Plan Kitten dry food along with one can of wet food daily. The kitten should be free-fed unless a veterinarian advises otherwise due to weight concerns. The kitten must be provided with a clean, safe, and secure environment at all times. Buyer Initials:
Breeding Restrictions & Legal Consequences
