What is Involved?

Adopt a spot at the Armco Park Solar Pollinator Habitat

Different sizes and restoration zones are available; pick what works best for you



Monitor your location

Identify emergent native plants and pollinators
Identify and manually remove invasive species
Report your findings using iNaturalist app



Suggested commitment of once a week, May through Oct

Adopt a spot with a few friends and divide the duties or make it a time to catch up



Great for lifelong learners

Learn plant identification, citizen science skills, and proper methods for invasives removal
Training, field guides and tools provided
