Participate VIRTUALLY from the safety and comfort of your own home, one of our parks, or anywhere you see birds!

HOW TO PARTICIPATE: Joining is easy, free, fun to do alone or with others in your household, and can be done anywhere you find birds! Go to www.BirdCount.org for general info about the count and how the data is used. Simply **watch birds for 15 minutes or more, at least once over the four days**, February 12-15, 2021, and report what you see!

Pick **the best tool to use for** sharing your bird sightings. Either option is great, and will contribute data to important scientific research so just opt for the one that works best for you!

- If you are new to the count and/or are an inexperienced birder, try using the <u>Merlin Bird ID app.</u>
- If you have participated in the count before or are an experienced birdwatcher, try <u>eBird Mobile app</u> or enter your bird list on the <u>eBird website</u> (desktop/laptop).

That's all there is to it! Your observations are part of a Citizen Science initiative that will help contribute to important research!
