Warren County Park District Park Pick-Up Volunteer Info.

As of 5/15/20, the Warren Co. Park District main office and playgrounds remain closed, but the parks are still open to individuals at this time. If you are interested in earning community service hours by picking up trash (at any of the parks) or sticks and branches (at Armco Park), please follow these steps so I can sign off on your hours. If you are picking up trash, you will need **trash bags, gloves, and hand sanitizer**. If you are picking up sticks and branches, you will need **gloves and hand sanitizer**. Please contact me if you need supplies.

There is no limit to the number of volunteer hours you can tally (on the Park District's end, at least) and no set time, so you can make your own schedule. Please note, THIS IS NOT A LARGE GROUP ACTIVITY; it is something you can do on your own or with your family. Focus on the edges of woods for trash, as that's where things tend to accumulate, and plan on using hand sanitizer as the restrooms may be locked. Please remember to continue to **follow preventative measures for Covid-19**—stay home when sick, use cough and sneeze etiquette, and practice hand hygiene as often as possible. Even when you are outside, remember to **practice safe and proper social distancing**; stay at least six feet away from others in the parks.

- 1) Go to one of the parks on this list (it's a great opportunity to explore one you've never visited before!) Please note, I can sign off on properties in this list ONLY. If you are interested in another park, please contact that facility's office.
- 2) Text me a pic of yourself with your supplies as you're getting ready to start.
- 3) **Do not pick up anything that looks sharp or potentially dangerous.** Heavy items, bottles that have liquid in them, or anything potentially dangerous should be left in place. Text me if you see anything like that and park staff can take care of it.
- 4) Garbage should be bagged and placed next to a trash receptacle in the park; sticks and branches at Armco Park should be piled around the base of trees.
- 5) Text me another pic of yourself and your trash bag(s) and/or your pile of sticks and branches when you are finished so I have a record of the amount of time you spent.
- 6) Leave your bag(s) of trash in or next to any trash receptacle or dumpster within the park.
