Community Connections

- Grants and donations received for \$500 each from Ohio Division of Wildlife Step Outside, Cabela's/Bass Pro Shops, and B&B Carryout to be used towards Cops and Bobbers event. This is in addition to the \$3500 donation we received from White Tails Unlimited Caesar Creek chapter to be used for Nature Education programs.
- **Great Horned Owl** chicks at Armco Park have fledged! The fencing around the tree will by removed by the Friends group on 5/18 after their meeting.
- **Scout Troop** planted pollinator friendly seeds in milk jug greenhouses. They will be transplanted into the butterfly garden at Landen Deerfield later in May.
