- 1/15: Met with Friends of WCPD **Cindy Glorius**, **Austin Langdon** and **Laura Stanton** to hang and fill birdfeeders outside Jones Pavilion in preparation for the Great Backyard Bird Count in February. Thank you to **Ray** for making new bird feeder hangers. They look great!
- 1/19: Jeff Hayes from **Raptor, Inc.** installed a **great horned owl nesting can** in an appropriate location near the maintenance barn.
- 1/19: Met with **Shannon Aquino** to revise **wedding brochure for Hisey Park**. See attached.
- 1/19: Started gathering applications for bands who are interested in our Fall Concert Series. Friends


