Community Connections

- Sent e-blasts reaching 1,055 people. In the past 28 days, Facebook posts have reached 6,347 people.
- Friends of WCPD have renewed their MailChimp subscription service on a month-to-month basis until a new Park District method can be found for sending e-blasts. I gave Shannon Aquino the list of everyone on our Friends distribution list to see if they can be imported into the new system.
- 3/24: Started working with Kings High School junior **Isabella Mussolino** to photograph and catalog the fossils that were donated to us by Friend of WCPD **David Barr**.
- 3/29: Met with **Shannon Aquino**, Friends president **Dianna Kenneally**, and Treasurer **Kathie Bowers** about new grant process for Friends to fund projects.
- 3/31: Touched base with **Tori Schretter** about her Girl Scout Gold project. She has selected the color palate and art design for her Little Free Library project at Landen-Deerfield Park. Larry approved via email. She is hoping to finish up in the next month or so.
- 4/3: Met with **Jeffrey Knight**, Eagle Scout candidate, about building animal nest boxes for the parks. We have had a number of flying squirrel occupants at Hisey Park using the nest boxes that Ohio Certified Volunteer Naturalists have previously installed.
- 4/3: Met with Rocknoll Energy's **Jim Yockey**, Friend of WCPD **April Hamlin** and several members of the **3 Valleys Conservation Foundation (3VCF)** about the Solar Pollinator Habitat, including the process we went through to get it established, success stories and how we have utilized the site, and challenges to consider if they want to replicate the project.
