
Nature Lovers Book Club

You can learn to identify trees by looking at the branching, leaves, twigs, bark, fruit and silhouette of the tree.

Branching

Leaf Shape

- Needled or broadleaf Simple or compound Smooth, lobed, toothed, or serrated edges Overall shape and size

At first glance, bark might seem to all look the same, but look closer. Bark varies in color (gray, gray-brown, brown, white, orange, or red-brown) and texture (smooth, scaly, furrowed, peeling, papery, or fibrous.)
