As people of faith there are some truths that are so familiar to us we may not think of them. Every Sunday we hear through the songs, the scripture and the message that God has promised to take care of us forever. We don't need to waste time being anxious about eternity because God has already taken care of that for us.

One of the emails I regularly get is from a group named Quora. They have questions that others, from varied backgrounds, answer. It is interesting to me that many of the questions lately have been around people wondering what happens when we die. These are clearly from people with no faith foundations. Some people ask if anyone has any proof. Others ask if there is heaven and hell. The question about if there even is an existence when our life here ends comes up regularly. There is a desperation that comes through the questions.

We as Christians are fortunate with our o<mark>rie</mark>ntation to heaven. That is where we are headed. And we know it. That makes life a lot more bearable. It brings hope. Here is how one guy put it:

"Many modern people have a secular humanist view where the facts are certain, but harsh: we will die and be utterly forgotten, and everything we have ever done will be forgotten and make no difference. Life is meaningless. Pleasure, suffering, good and evil are pointless. Nothing matters. How depressing!

On the other hand, we have a Christian worldview. The facts are uncertain but hopeful: we will die but be resurrected, and everything we have ever done has contributed to the Divine Plan. Life is only the beginning, to be followed by divine joy. Everything, even the smallest detail matters a great deal."

I thought that if you hadn't thought about the assurance of your salvation lately this could be a reminder. You don't have to worry, Jesus has us covered!

August has seen additional expenses over and above our monthly expenses. There was a repair and replacement of the conference room window for a cost of \$1845. We paid for our annual subscription to ICON Systems donation tracking program for \$649.00. We needed to repair the back flow system which cost \$500. These costs total \$2,994.00.

Our standard monthly expenses include Payroll, payroll taxes, Quickbooks costs, PG&E, water, garbage, copier, mortgage payment on the community center, Comcast, insurance, janitorial and yard maintenance.


We also want to thank our church friends providing groceries distribute to Roeding
