The next steps for the PNC will be to meet with the Presbytery (of Western New York) representative for an orientation to the process of searching for a pastor and first steps related to posting the position on the national church website. Please keep our PNC in your prayers—that they will be led to the clergy person "out there" in the wider church who is the perfect match to lead UPC in its next chapter of life and ministry.

Summer is not over, of course, and there are some mid/late summer congregation events in the planning stages—opportunities to be with friends in this glorious season in our beautiful part of the creation. Shakespeare in the Park, Chautauqua, a BPO outdoor performance...keep on the lookout. We'll get the word out via Sunday morning announcements, emails and word of mouth.

In the meantime, on behalf of the church staff and session enjoy the beauty of the earth and the wonder of human relationships.
