GENERAL JOB DESCRIPTION

Pulling (skidding) merchantable timber to the roadside and/or chipper for harvesting.

- Operating the skidder in a safe and efficient manner
- Working in harmony with other forestry equipment to keep operations running efficiently
- Daily machine inspections
- Daily machine maintenance including greasing and fueling
- Operating CB radio
- Perform other job-related duties as assigned

- Forest Pit and Road Construction Equipment Operator – Common Core
- Machine Qualification or experience (preferred)
