Easy Zipper Pouch (Beginner Friendly Sewing Pattern!) by Erica Arndt on YouTube

Supplies: 2 zipper tabs 2.5 x 2.5. 2 tops and 2 lining pieces. One zip. Zipper one inch shorter than the width of the panel.

Press zipper tabs in half and 1/4 inch on both sides.

Place zipper into tabs. Sew along the edge to secure. Trim excess fabric.

Lay fabric right side up. Place zipper right side down on top of fabric. Place lining on top. Sew all three layers. Press. Move zipper head. Leave needle in the down position, lift presser foot to move zipper head.

Repeat for other side. Add batting if desired. Or fuse inner facing.

Unzip zipper 3/4 of the way. Very important. Right sides together, lining together. Pin or clip all 4 sides. Sew 1/4 inch around all 4 sides of the bag, leaving a 3 inch space in the bottom of the lining piece. Backstitch at stop and start. Trim corners. Turn right side out. Poke corners. Stitch lining hole to close. Push lining into bag. Press.
