That search led to his successful application for a supervisory position at one of the legacy Co-op Gas Station in yorkton. "Luckily, my neighbor had worked at the legacy Co-op for five years and she was my reference".

create a positive impression and continues pave the way for future immigrant hires. He and his family has now received Permanent Residency status and will start a brand new job at CN Rails, as he aims to become a Train Engineer. to do the same saying that "if


