Saskatchewan receives increased immigration quota

Saskatchewan has received an increase of 1,136 nominations under the Saskatchewan Immigrant Nominee Program (SINP) for 2025. This brings the total allocation for the year under the SINP to 4,761. These are sectors that reached their <u>25%</u> nomination cap in June, after which the SINP began returning applications in these sectors. With the increase in allocations, processing for some applications in these sectors will begin again.


