Corpus Christi Africa Fund 2025 Appeal

Thanks to everyone, both Parishioners and Friends of CCAF, for the fantastic response to our appeal throughout 2024. As a result we have been able to send £18,000 in January 2025 to Our Lady of Nazareth Comprehensive School, in Nairobi, to assist towards funding their 2025 Uji porridge programme, as well as contributing £5,000 towards the cost of a new Girls toilet block, and a further £5,000 contribution to the ongoing renovations to the older classrooms. OLN now provides Uji to over 3,000 pupils as the school expands to reflect changes to the Primary & Secondary Education system in Kenya. As a result of these changes the school is now known as Our Lady of Nazareth Comprehensive School, as it now caters for Pre Primary, Primary, and part Secondary education

We were delighted to welcome Fr Gabriel of the Marianists, two teachers, and four pupils to Corpus Christi in September 2024, when they came on a one week visit to Wokingham. This trip was fully funded by donors at Holme Grange School.

The South Berkshire Singers again held their annual Christmas concert at Corpus Christi in December 2024 and this resulted in £4,000 being raised. Our thanks to them, and all who supported this concert.

OLN Update from Jeremy Best/Nick Gorton

Jeremy has still not been able to personally visit Kenya since 2019.He continues to keep in close contact with Fr Gabriel of the Marianists and the school. He hopes very much to visit sometime during 2025. Fellow Committee Member Nick Gorton is hoping to make a further visit to OLN in 2025.

The financing of the Uji porridge, which we have assisted with over many years, remains one of the biggest challenges for the Marianists in Nairobi. Additionally, as the school increases in size, there are always other costs with which we can assist should we raise sufficient funds for Uji. We shall continue to make the provision of Uji the main purpose of our fundraising in 2025, to help cover the overall Uji costs for 2026. We feel that we should be looking at again providing at least **£18,000**, but hopefully much more as our contribution to the overall costs **The cost per child continues to be just £10 per year in 2025.**

Several Parishioners have made individual donations to the Special Needs Unit, which continues to provide education and care to children with disabilities. A number of parishioners have also very generously given funds to support some of the former OLN children go on to secondary education. We are very grateful for their support. The cost is roughly **£2,000 before Gift Aid** for four years. This does not need to be donated in one amount and can be paid at the start of each academic year which runs from January. As ever, the pupils and their teachers at OLN, together with the Marianists are extremely grateful for your generosity. However much you give, large or small, all makes a huge difference.
