PROJECT UPDATE



Since our last update, I am pleased to report a lot of progress has occurred with the Siouxland Expo Center! The building is really coming to life with the addition of the windows and façade. The rusting steel on the face of the building will be installed next week. The inside of the building is really taking shape as well. The second-floor mezzanine is going to really impress.

Currently, contractors are working to complete the roof, façade, windows, exterior site paving, and the interior finishes. There have only been some minor delays due to COVID-19, the retractable bleachers, the dividing partition for the conference room, and acoustical wall for the arena. These are the only delays that we are aware of which may not impact the completion date.

We are still looking at a July completion. Whether or not we can begin operations at that time will remain to be seen. We were planning on a grand opening celebration in July with the donors and stakeholders however, that may have to be held at a later date.
