
# Congregation COVID-19 Survey Results

Q1: When our local government lifts its ban or guidance against churches meeting, which best describes your attitude toward returning to a worship service at church? Select one:




- 55% will return at first opportunity
- More than half of those will do so with precautions
- 26% will wait some amount of time before returning
- 19% are not sure

- 55% desire the number of nearby cases to be very small
- 26% desire most social distancing requirements to be lifted
- Roughly 1 in 5 wish to see locals schools open again
- One third would like to see local businesses
   & restaurants open again




- 87% say they will wear a face mask


t	Clean sanctuary between services Mask / gloves Worn when giving Lord's supper. Bread & wine to be put in small cups to be distributed.
<del></del>	Have a screen in front of the church with words of our hymns Worship on the lawn on nice days, no masks
Ŷ	Have one person open the door at the end of the church service. So no one else has to touch it. Entering and exiting should be one way anyway. Since people are coming in at the start of service and leaving at the end.
÷	I am not concerned for my families safety but will make every effort to be respectful of anyone else's concerns. We will hug everyone or wave from a distance based in what the others are comfortable with.
÷	Make it clear to all members of the congregation that precautions are expected to be followed by everyone. wear a face covering to keep you safe. You wear a face covering to keep me safe. It is a matter of mutual care and respect. Face covering and social distancing only works when everyone participates.
t	One servicechurch is dirty how and who will clean and sanitize?
t	Outdoor service when possible

#### Q5: Would you be willing to attend your small group such as PW or Crafts Club where it typically meets?




- Overall about 50% of respondents participate in a small group.

Q6: Which of the following describes the attendance level at which you would be comfortable attending a worship service? I would be comfortable attending if the sanctuary is...




- 61% would be comfortable with the sanctuary half full
- 26% would are more comfortable at ¼ full
- 10% are not comfortable opening right away
- One person would be comfortable with a full sanctuary










- 55% would prefer to resume in person worship right away
- 26% are not sure
- 16% say to continue with what we are doing
- One person would prefer meeting in small groups in homes before return to in person worship


- 45% of replies would be willing to meet at a different time vs 29% that would not be willing to do so
- 32% would be willing to consider an overflow room vs 16% who would not
- 16% are not sure


#### Q9: How long have you been attending?
