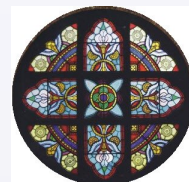

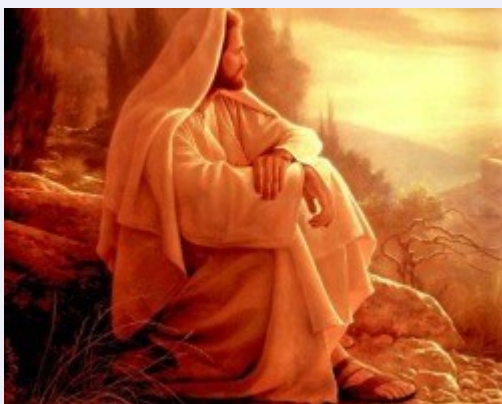


## I Believe In The Trinity

Philippians reads, "Who, being in very nature God did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made

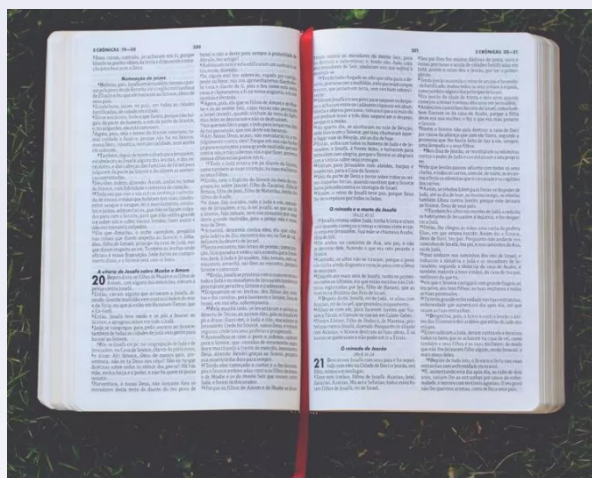

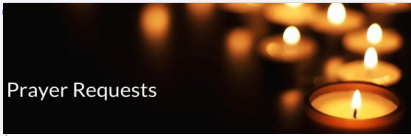

### Turkey Basil Burgers

|-----------------------------|--------------------|
| 4 T finely chopped onion    | ¼ t pepper         |
| 4-6 T fine dry bread crumbs | ¼ C skim milk      |
| 3 T dried basil             | 1 lb ground turkey |
| ¼ t salt                    |                    |

Mix together all the dry ingredients and then add the milk until it makes a moist paste. It may take a little less or a little more than the ¼ cup. Then add in the ground turkey and mix with your hands until the herb mixture and turkey are well combined. Form into 4 patties and grill on medium/low heat for about 13 - 15 minutes until juices run clear.



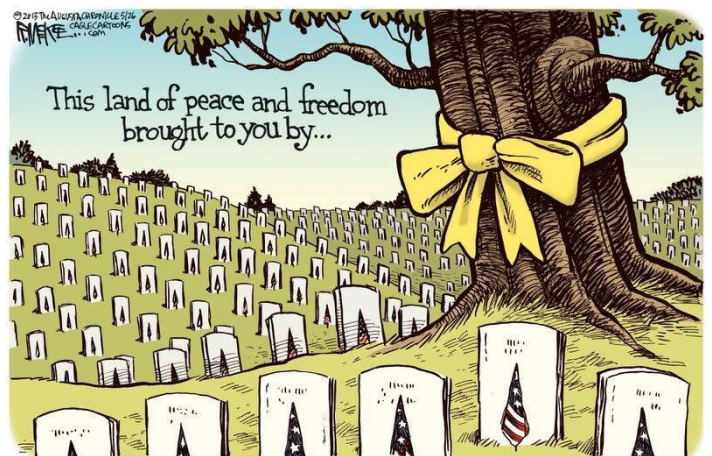
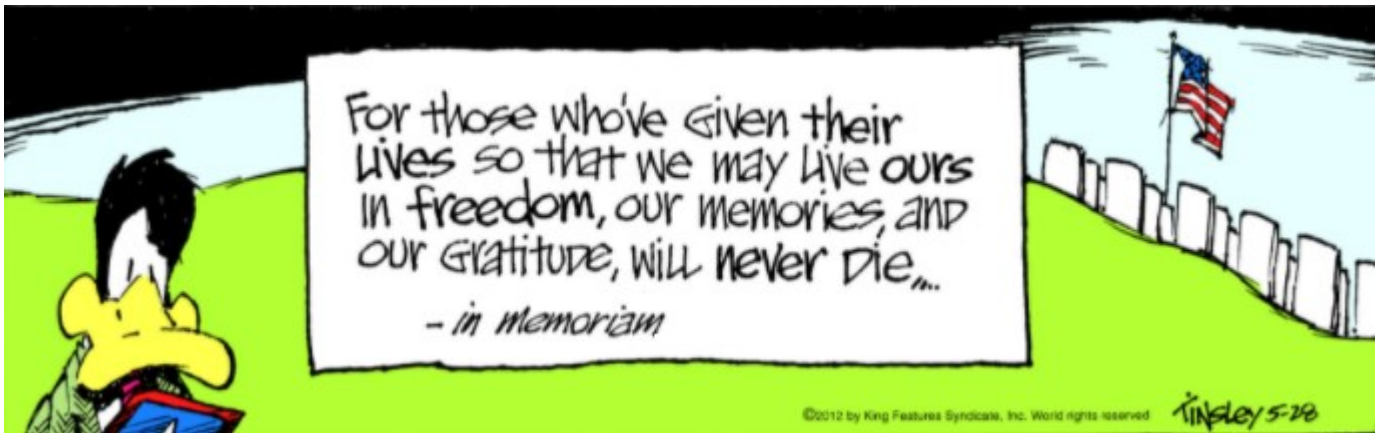
