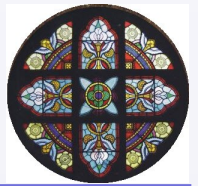

The Beauty Of Miracles

I believe in miracles.

Now, that may sound clichéd, but I mean it genuinely. Some people may call this a story of fate, but I know that it is a miracle. A miracle occurs when something happens that is beyond a person's control and enhances his or her

life for the better. My family encountered such an experience on September 11, 2001.

My dad has worked as a laborer in New York City since before I was born. The World Trade Center was where he spent each of his workdays until the year 2001. During the summer of that year, ownership of the buildings that comprised the complex was transferred from one company to another.



Unfortunately, the conversion was costing my dad his job since the new company was bringing in its own people to take his and his fellow co-workers' places. I hardly saw my dad that summer because he needed to be at work almost constantly during that hectic time. Week after week, he was told to come into work for yet another week. He had no idea when his layoff date would occur.

Tuesday, September 4 was the day that changed my family's life, although we did not know that at the time. It was the day my dad was laid off as well as the day that marked the one week period before the September 11 terrorist attacks that took place at the World Trade Center. If my dad was told on that day to come into work for one more week, he most likely would no longer be alive.

His job took him all around the Twin Towers and the other surrounding buildings. He could have been anywhere in the buildings at the time of the attack, even on the roof.

To most people, losing their job is one of the worst things that can possibly happen to them. For my dad, losing his job was a miracle. Several of his co-workers died on that unfortunate day and it hurts me to think that my dad could have been right there with them. I do not know what I would do if he was not in my life. I would be without a father, my mom would be without a husband, and my sister would have never met her father. My life and my family's life would be so drastically different that I cannot even imagine what it would be like. I love my dad with all my heart and count my blessings each day that he has been given the opportunity to live his life.





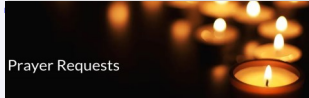
