

Do I Need to Hire A Wedding Planner or a Day of Coordinator? What's the Difference?

Wedding Planners are all about the logistics, from vendor referrals and contract negotiation to day-of-execution of your vision. Planners take the guesswork out of the process, making planning a wedding as seamless and smooth as possible. A wedding planner handles a multitude of tasks, both in the months leading up to the event and on the big day as well, to help lessen the load for busy couples, help keep track of budgets and handle the logistics. Wedding Planners are experts in their field and use their vast knowledge and extensive contacts to help design and bring your wedding vision to life.

While a wedding planner addresses logistics along the wedding planning journey, A Day-of Coordinator is logistically focused, but on a shorter timeline than a planner. They usually begin helping you prepare about a month before the wedding and function as the point-person on the wedding day. They are the person who creates a full comprehensive timeline for your day or weekend, coordinates the rehearsal and ceremony, will be close to your side during the event day to keep you on a timeline and will manage setup and breakdown of your wedding decor. Coordinators make sure everything you've done, up until the time they take over is in good shape. Hiring a Day-Of Coordinator to take over the month before your wedding gives them time to tweak any details and follow upon on loose ends, along you more time to relax and enjoy the weeks before saying I do! Many couples hire a Day-Of Coordinator if they are planning their wedding themselves and need someone to oversee their work on the big day.

🖴 Full-Service Wedding Planner

Handles the entire planning process from start to finish.

- Initial consultation to understand vision, priorities, and budget
- Ongoing planning meetings and unlimited communication
- Venue selection assistance and site visit coordination

- Budget development and ongoing expense tracking
- Wedding design and styling (theme, colors, décor)

- Rehearsal coordination and management
- Full-day coordination on the wedding day
- Oversight of vendor arrivals, setup, and breakdown

(Day-of (or Month-of) Coordinator

- Initial meeting (usually 4-8 weeks before the wedding)
- Review of vendor contracts and logistics you've already arranged
- Creation of a detailed wedding day timeline
- Final venue walk-through
- · Confirmation and communication with all vendors
- Rehearsal coordination (typically 1 hour)
- Full-day coordination on the wedding day
- · Oversee vendor setup and deliveries
- Keep the day on schedule and handle transitions
- Manage emergencies or last-minute issues
- Assist with cleanup and breakdown coordination
