

“Playing 4 Par” – JUNIORS – Spring 2025 Golf Classes at Southgate GC/Driving Range

TUESDAYS – Jan 14-May 13 , 2025 – 4-5pm

“Playing 4 Par” is a new program created here at Southgate to develop new, beginner, intermediate and advanced golfers by learning and mastering the fundamentals of golf, and the rules, so they can enjoy the game for a lifetime. We start closer to the hole and through a players practice and development, they progress to play further away from the hole as they improve, with the goal to eventually play from the regular golf teeing areas. By starting closer to the hole, every hole is a par 4. Each instruction week, golfers learn, practice and test their ability over the course of the program. There will be weeks of testing their skills to advance to another level. This program begins with children being separated by age and then by skill. We will have 2 stations each week with an instructor doing a certain skill each week.

Kids rotate each week to a different station/skill. Practice will be needed in between each class.

Each week at each station, coaches will:

- 1) **Teach** a Skill & Rule – **Show** a specific method or technique for that station’s skill and rules they will need to learn
- 2) **Drill** the Skill – Provide a drill for the student to do and **Reinforce** that skill to become more proficient
- 3) **Practice** the Skill – Instructors supervise practicing of the drill and work to improve the skill with additional instruction
- 3) **Test** the Skill by **Challenging** player. Competitions, Playing & Keeping Score, Skills/Testing Challenges.
