Fruit Salsa

Ingredients

- 1 qt strawberries, chopped
- 1 Granny Smith apple, chopped
- 2 kiwis, peeled and chopped
- 2 Tbsp orange juice
- 2 Tbsp brown sugar
- 2 Tbsp apricot jam*
- Cinnamon tortilla chips or pita chips

Directions

I put all the fruit in a food processor, 2 cups at a time. The apples need to be really chopped fine.

Then mix the fruit with the orange juice, brown sugar, and jam.

*You can substitute any flavor jam you have.

I buy Stacey's Cinnamon Pita Chips. If you can find them, there are cinnamon tortilla chips out there. (They were in Michigan.)
