In-Kind Donation Offer

An in-kind donation is a non-cash contribution of goods or services given to a nonprofit or organization, essentially a donation of items or labor instead of money, like donating food, office supplies, professional expertise, or volunteer time, which helps organizations save costs and fulfill their missions. The value recorded for these donations is usually the fair market price the organization would have paid to acquire them.

Examples of In-Kind Donations

- **Goods:** Food, computers, furniture, clothing, vehicles, toys, or medical supplies.
- **Services:** Free legal advice, event planning, website design, plumbing work, or marketing expertise.
- **Time/Labor:** Volunteer hours (e.g., crafting or helping at an event).

Why They're Important

- **Saves Money:** Allows nonprofits to get needed items/services they couldn't afford to buy.
- **Expands Reach:** Provides tangible support for operations, events (as auction items), and direct beneficiary aid.
- **Builds Relationships:** Offers donors a tangible way to support a cause, increasing engagement.
- **Operational Support:** Essential for food pantries, shelters, and other community organizations.

What are the IRS rules for in-kind donations?

Generally, a donor may deduct an in-kind (or, non-cash) donation as a charitable contribution. And a donor must obtain a written acknowledgment from the charity to substantiate the gift, although the acknowledgment will generally not assign a dollar value to the donation.
