HABITAT FOR HUMANITY WORKDAY Signup instructions

An event for First Presbyterian has been created for August 3.

- 1. Go to <u>https://helenahabitat.volunteerhub.com/vv2/</u> This will take you to the home page of HHH's volunteer tracking site.
- 2. In the top right corner of the page, you will see a green "Create Account" button. Click on that.
- 3. It will ask you to **create a username and password** and it will want you to verify the password again. Click "NEXT" to continue.
- 4. This page will ask you some general questions. **These don't have to be checked for you to continue**, but if you are interested in checking them please do so. Click "NEXT" to continue.
- 5. This page will ask you for your name, email address, mobile phone number, and date of birth. (**These are the only required fields** that will have to be answered.) You don't have to put in your physical address. Click "NEXT" to continue.
- 6. This next page will let you know that you have successfully created your account. Click "NEXT" to continue.
- 7. A window will pop up. This is our standard waiver that we have all volunteers agree to. If you agree, **put a check next to the "I understand and accept the waiver above**." Then click "ACCEPT" to continue.
- 8. This next page should look like a calendar. If you scroll down to August 3rd you will see a link that says "Welcome back First Presbyterian Church!" Click on that link and it will bring you to a page that gives you some details about the build day. There will be a link to a "Safety Video." (We don't require that you watch the video, but we do recommend that you do.) You will also see a green button on the right side of the page that says "SIGN UP." If you click on that, it will register you for the event.
- 9. That's it. You're all done! Everyone who signs up for the event will receive an email the day before the event, just to remind you. 24 hours after the event, you will receive another email with a link to a survey. If anyone would like to fill it out and let us know how your build day went, that would be great, but not required. The feedback gives us some good ideas on where we can improve our processes.
- 10. If you need to cancel once you've registered, you can do so by logging into your profile at this same website.
