



140	General Crook Trail	5.3 Portion shown on Woods Canyon Area Trails map. (Total trail length on Black Mesa = 58.4)		More Difficult	The General Crook Trail is Arizona's first designated State Historic Trail; a 113 mile trail built by Gen. George Crook in the 1870's, during the Apache War. Crooks trail crosses the Black Mesa Ranger District through mixed ponderosa pine & Gambel oak. On this map, the trail can be accessed from Carr Lake Trailhead on the west side, trail then travels eastward to junction with FR 300 near Rim Top trailhead. The Meadow trail (505), Military Sinkhole trail (179), and Rim Lakes Vista trail (622) can be accessed from this portion of trail.	<p>General Crook Trail Profile</p> <p>Profile depicted on graph is just the portion of General Crook Trail shown on the Woods Canyon Area Trails map.</p>
116	Woods Canyon Nature Trail	0.9		Easiest	Access this trail from the Rocky Point trailhead and travels north west to a junction with Woods Canyon Lake Trail (336) near the shore line of Woods Canyon Lake.	<p>Woods Canyon Nature Trail Profile</p>
116A	Woods Canyon Nature Trail Conn	0.1		Easiest	This trail provides a shortcut along the Woods Canyon Nature Trail (116). Trail can be accessed by following the 116 trail from the Rocky Point trailhead for approximately 0.5 miles, trail cuts across the drainage and cuts off approximately 0.2 miles of the 116 trail.	<p>Woods Canyon Nature Trail Conn Profile</p>
116B	Woods Canyon Lake Connector Trail	0.03		Easiest	This trail provides a short access between Woods Canyon Nature Trail (116) and Woods Canyon Lake Trail (336) at the Woods Canyon Lake Trailhead.	<p>Woods Canyon Lake Connector Trail Profile</p>
179	Military Sinkhole Trail	0.4		Moderate	Trail begins along the General Crook Trail (140) and travels south to the Rim edge at the Military Sinkhole Observation overlook.	<p>Military Sinkhole Trail Profile</p>
336	Woods Canyon Lake Trail	2.7		More Difficult	This trail begins at the Woods Canyon Lake Trailhead. The trail travels around the lake mainly following the lake shore. Trail ends near the Spillway campground. There is access along the shore to the boat ramp parking area. Vault toilet is available at the parking area.	<p>Woods Canyon Lake Trail Profile</p>
505	Meadow Trail	1.6		Easy	Trail begins at the Boat Ramp parking area (near store) and proceeds to the south to the junction with FR 300. Trail follows FR 105 and provides trail access to many of the campgrounds in the Woods Canyon Lake Recreation area.	<p>Meadow Trail Profile</p>
507	Rim Campground Trail	0.2		Easy	Trail begins at the Boat Ramp parking area (near store) and proceeds to the south to the junction with FR 300. Trail follows FR 105 and provides trail access to many of the campgrounds in the Woods Canyon Lake Recreation area.	<p>Rim Campground Trail Profile</p>
622	Rim Lakes Vista Trail	4.3		Easy	Trail begins at the Rim Top Trailhead and proceeds westward to the Mogollon campground. This trail is wheelchair accessible. From this trail can also access the Rim Campground Trail (507). Military Sinkhole Trail (179) and Meadow Trail (505). From Military Sinkhole can also access the Highline National Recreational Trail which is on the Tonto National Forest.	<p>Rim Lakes Vista Trail Profile</p>
