WITNESSETH

That the said parties are the present owners and proprietors of the following tract or parcel of land situated in Falls Church Magisterial District, Fairfax County, Virginia, and being described by metes and bounds, according to a survey thereof made by Walter L. Phillips, Certified Land Surveyor, as follows, to-wit:

"Beginning at a concrete monument in the line of Campbell marking a corner to Williams and the northeast corner of Section One, Pine Ridge Subdivision; thence with the north boundary of said Section One, Pine Ridge Subdivision N. 73° 10' 50" W. 507.20 feet to a point in the east line of a street 16 feet wide (Williams Drive); thence with the said east side of a street 16 feet wide (Williams Drive); thence with the said east side of a street 16 feet wide (Williams Drive) N. 21° 34' 00" E., 825.37 feet to the south line of a street 20 feet wide (Highland Road); thence with said south line of a street 20 feet wide (Highland Road) S. 71° 45' 50" E., 211.10 feet to the west line of lot P; thence departing said south line of a street 20 feet wide (Highland Road) and with the west line of 10ts P&Q, S. 21° 14' 10" W. 361.98 feet to a concrete monument marking the southwest corner of said lot Q; thence with the said south line of lot Q, S. 68° 45' 20" E. 120.00 feet to the west line of a street 20 feet wide (Spring Street); thence with the said west line of a street 20 feet wide (Spring Street) S. 21° 14' 40" W., 200.30 feet to a point; thence across'said west line of a street 20 feet wide (Spring Street) S. 68° 45' 20" E., 20.00 feet to the east line of said street 20 feet wide (Spring Street) and the southwest corner of lot V; thence with the south line of lot V, S. 57° 26' 50" E. 244.52 feet to a concrete monument in the line of Campbell; thence with the line of Campbell, S. 46° 50' 10" W., 207.43 feet to the beginning and containing 6.376 acres."

Plat of said subdivision, made and prepared by Walter L. Phillips, Certified Land Surveyor, dated October 21, 1950, and approved December 13, 1950, by William T. Henry, County Planning Engineer, approved December 13, 1950, by the Fairfax County Health Department, by F. C. Heath, Health Officer, and further approved December 19, 1950, by the Board of Supervisors of Fairfax County, Virginia, by R. M. Loughborough, Executive Secretary, showing the various lots therein, is hereto attached and expressly made a part hereof, and reference thereto is now made for a further description of the dimensions, length and width of said land so subdivided.

This deed of dedication is made expressly subject, however, to the following conditions and restrictions, to-wit:

1. No cows, horses, goats or sheep, and not more than two

hogs shall be raised, kept or maintained on any lot in said subdivision, nor shall any chickens or fowl of any kind or character be raised or maintained commercially on any land in said subdivision.

2. No dwelling house shall be constructed on any lot in said subdivision costing less than \$2,500.00 to completely construct.

The foregoing restrictions and conditions are each constituted as covenants to bind the said land and all subsequent owner or owners thereof, either in whole or in part.
