Technology

VGV has a Microsoft Azura system of:

- 225 student workstations with virtual desktops and thin client connectivity
- Enterprise grade blade server system
- 350 runs of cat 6 network cabling
- 31 wireless APs placed by heat mapping
- Integrated VOIP phones, security, cameras, and access control points for attendance taking
- Dell laptops and Chromebooks for Workshops
- Microsoft home access (username and password brings up the desktop as if the user were at school)
- Liquid Labs and Profile Unity for ongoing end user digital environment maintenance
- 8 hours of battery back-up (400 pounds of APC units)
- Environmental sensors with alert protocols and two dedicated air conditioning units for the server room (primary and aux).
- Workshops are equipped with an LCD projector, laptop, Chromecast, and ELMO (document camera).
- Discover Video (Devos) complete cloud and on-premises secure video streaming/communication platform for Digital Signage, morning and afternoon announcements and priority alerts.
