Village Green Charter School Teaching and Learning Overview

At Village Green Charter School, students engage in daily, face-to-face, student-centered instruction with Rhode Island-certified teachers in ELA, math, science, and history. Classes are 66 minutes in length, except on Wednesdays when they are shortened to 55 minutes to allow for schoolwide club activities. Each classroom is intentionally capped at 16 students to support personalized instruction.

Village Green provides dedicated student enrichment time on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays, during which students receive targeted academic support from their content teachers, either one-on-one or in small groups.

Teachers at Village Green serve dual roles as both skill gap interventionists and data analysts, guiding students through a rigorous, college-preparatory curriculum. The school implements high-quality instructional materials including Illustrative Math, Odell Education for ELA, OpenSciEd for science, and Edgenuity for history and electives.

All teachers utilize Google Classroom to enhance instruction with supplemental, curriculum-aligned assignments. In addition, platforms such as Imagine Learning, Khan Academy, and ReadTheory are used to reinforce and differentiate learning based on student needs. Dedicated attention is given to providing additional support for special population students, including multilingual learners (MLLs) and those with IEPs or 504 plans. These digital tools help target skill gaps, support language development, and provide personalized learning opportunities.

Instruction at Village Green is delivered through a blend of teacher-led and student-paced learning (SPL), with a 1:1 student-to-Chromebook ratio in all classrooms, ensuring access to technology-enhanced learning experiences.

At Village Green, a student's Individualized Learning Plan (ILP) is developed through participation in Career Planning & Development I, II, III, and IV, a four-year course sequence that is embedded into each student's academic program. These courses guide students in exploring career pathways, setting postsecondary goals, and aligning their academic choices with future aspirations. During their senior year, students may take between one and four dual enrollment courses and/or participate in an ILP-aligned internship, providing them with authentic college and career readiness experiences as they transition to post-secondary opportunities.

Graduation Requirements:

Students will graduate from Village Green with between 23 and 26 credits, depending on their selected coursework and enrichment opportunities.

Senior Year Options:

During their senior year, students have the opportunity to personalize their educational experience. Seniors may be eligible to enroll in up to two Dual Enrollment courses per semester, earning both high school and college credit. Additionally, students may participate in semester- or year-long internships, provided the experience aligns with their ILP and supports their long-term academic and career goals.
