      \*If you become a member of Lee-ettes and Ballet Company, you will not pay \$125 under "Event Fees" twice; it will be \$15 to add the 2nd performing group.
  - Christmas Ballet Participation Fee \$25 (this fee is for anyone performing who is not already in the Christmas Ballet includes video of performance)
