$\bigcirc$	Yard Slope: Yard slopes toward the

$\bigcirc$	HVAC Unit: Old rusted systems, loud		
	noises, poor airflow		
$\bigcirc$	Water Heater: Look for rust around		
	base, ask about age (10+ years =		
	replacement soon)		
$\bigcirc$	Electrical Panel: Any visible damage		
	or confusion in labeling = ask		
	questions		
$\bigcirc$	Plumbing: Look at exposed pipes—		
	any corrosion, strange materials, or		

signs of leaking?

## **INTERIORS**

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Int	erior Red Flags:
	Walls/Ceilings: Cracks, stains
	(especially brown/yellow water spots),
	sagging drywall
$\bigcirc$	Floors: Uneven or sloped floors, soft
	spots, squishy carpet (moisture
	underneath?)
$\bigcirc$	Windows: Difficult to open/close, fog
	between panes (broken seals), signs of
	past leaks
$\bigcirc$	Smells: Musty odors (may indicate
	mold), overpowering scents (trying to
_	cover something?)
$\bigcirc$	<b>Doors:</b> Sticking, misaligned frames
$\overline{}$	(could mean foundation movement)
$\bigcirc$	Kitchen & Baths: Water damage unde
	sinks, moldy caulk, leaking faucets,
$\sim$	outdated plumbing
$\bigcirc$	Attic Access: If accessible—peek at
$\overline{}$	insulation, signs of leaks, or pests
$\bigcup$	Basement or Crawlspace: Dampness,
	mold, standing water, or a "wet
	basement" smell

## SMART QUESTIONS TO ASK THE AGENT WHILE WALKING THROUGH

How old is the roof, HVAC, and water heater?
 Have there been any past foundation or drainage repairs? Is there a history of water intrusion?
 Are there any recent updates or renovations—and were they permitted?
 Why are the current owners moving?

Does the layout match my lifestyle? Are there enough	
bathrooms, storage, or office space?	
What's the commute and neighborhood feel like?
