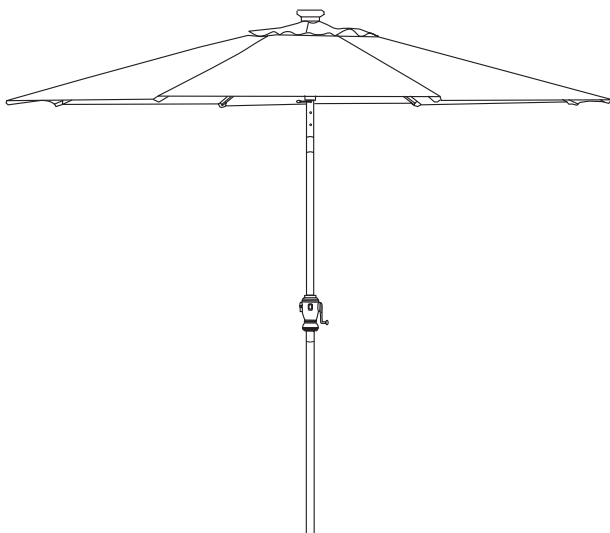

- Securely fasten the umbrella to an appropriately size umbrella base. Do not install into the ground.
- This seasonal use product is not intended for permanent installation or use.



DANGER: Do not use near open flame or other heat sources.



CAUTION: Do not use the umbrella in windy conditions. Store the closed umbrella indoors



CAUTION: Do not attempt to alter the wiring or operate the umbrella without all LEDs in place



CAUTION: Do not use this product for other than its intended purpose.

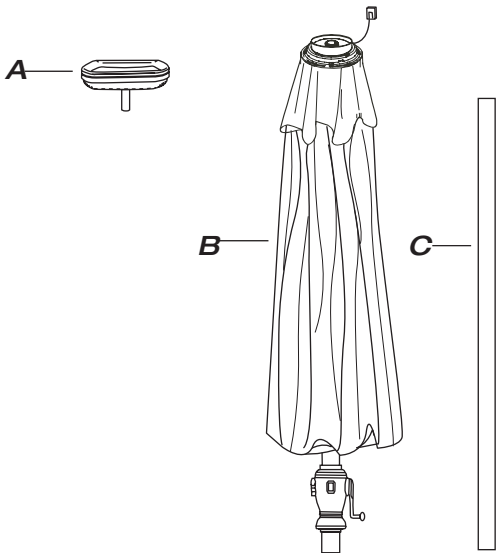
WHAT IS NOT COVERED

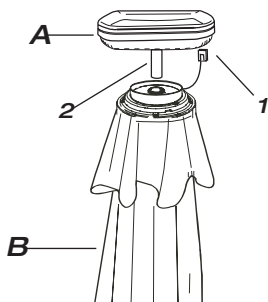

Assembly

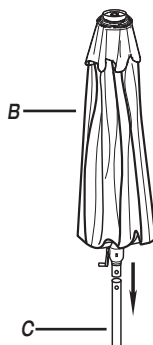
1 Attaching the solar panel

- Position the solar panel (A) on top of the umbrella (B).
- Insert the connector plug (1) attached to the umbrella into the receptacle located on the back of the solar panel (A).
- Insert the solar panel stem (2) into the top of the umbrella. Turn the solar panel (A) clockwise to lock and secure.



2 Attaching the umbrella to the umbrella pole

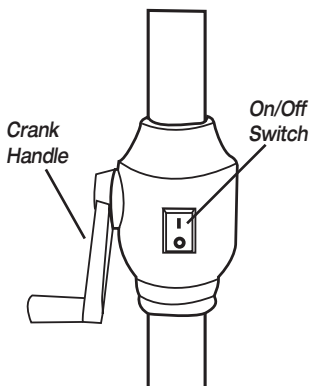
- (See Figure 2) Align hole at end of umbrella (B) with push button at top of lower umbrella pole (C).
- Depress push button and insert umbrella into lower umbrella pole until push button locks.
- Place umbrella upright in a heavy weighted stand (not included), and table capable of firmly securing the umbrella.



Operation

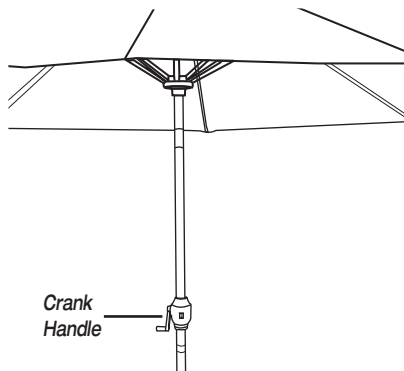
1 Turning on the solar lights

- Once the batteries are fully charged, place the power switch to the ON "I" position.
 - Refer to the section entitled "Charging the batteries".
- Notice: Set the switch to the off "O" position when solar



2 Adjusting the umbrella up or down

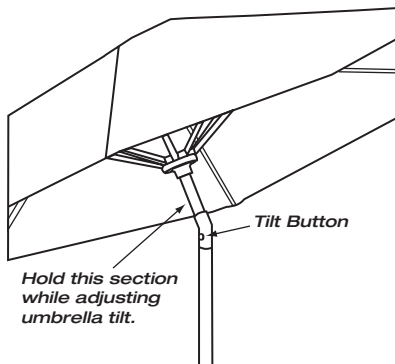
- Using the crank handle, raise umbrella to desired height. Turn crank handle clockwise to open the umbrella.



Operation (continued)

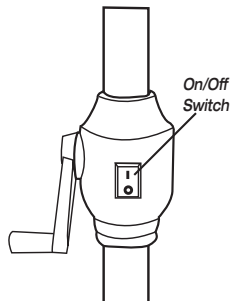
3 Adjusting the umbrella tilt angle

- With the tilt button pushed inward, move umbrella to desired location, then release button to lock in position.
- With the tilt button pushed inward, move umbrella to desired location, then release button to lock in position.



4 Charging the batteries

- Verify that the power switch (1) is in the OFF "O" position.
- Place the fully assembled solar umbrella in full sun, away from streetlights or other light sources where it will receive direct sunlight for at least 8 hours per day.

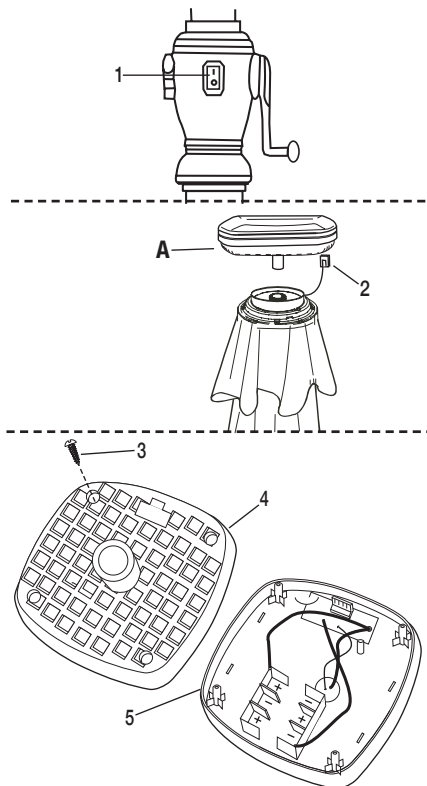


NOTE: The rechargeable batteries are preinstalled from the factory. Before operating, the batteries need to be fully charged. The batteries require at least 8-hours of full sunlight to charge.

NOTE: The number of hours light is illuminated is directly proportional to the number of hours of sunlight it receives. The solar panels cannot recharge the batteries if light is obstructed.

1 Replacing the batteries

- ❑ We recommend replacing rechargeable batteries once a year.
- ❑ Place the power switch (1) to OFF "O" position.
- ❑ Lower the solar umbrella, and place it on a flat non-abrasive surface.
- ❑ Remove the solar panel (A) from the top of the umbrella, turn counter-clockwise to unlock and separate.
- ❑ Carefully unplug the connector plug (2) from the solar panel receptacle.
- ❑ Remove and retain the four small screws (3) from the cover (4) and remove the cover.
- ❑ Remove and replace the old batteries with new rechargeable batteries of the same rating.
- ❑ Install new batteries in the proper direction and reference polarity (+/-) markings on the battery compartment (5) for the correct placement.
- ❑ Replace the battery cover (4) and secure with four screws retained.
- ❑ Insert the umbrella connector plug (2) into receptacle located on the bottom of the battery compartment.
- ❑ Insert the solar panel back into the top of the umbrella.
- ❑ Turn the solar panel clockwise to lock and secure.
- ❑ Refer to the section entitled "Charging the batteries" on page 5 to restore the solar lights to full operation.



Care and Cleaning

- Gently clean the solar panel and LEDs with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasives or chemicals to clean the solar panel. Remove dust and debris using a soft cloth or duster.
- Rinse the umbrella with clear, clean water. If necessary, use a gentle fabric cleaner, rated safe for polyester fabrics.
