I. COMPETITION OVERVIEW

The BSA 3rd National Figure Skating Championships will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of Barbados Ice Skating Association (BSA), as set forth in the current rulebook, as well as any pertinent updates that have been posted on BSA website, www.barbadosskating.org.

This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules.

Skaters must be a currently registered member of a Barbados Skating Association member club, a collegiate club or who is an individual member in accordance with the current rulebook. For non-Barbadian citizens, please refer to the rulebook for more information.

COACHES:

To be an eligible coach at a non-qualifying competition, coaches must meet the applicable compliance requirements and be verified by the Barbados Ice Skating Association (BSA). Coach compliance falls into two categories, Coach Compliance (includes choreographers) and Learn to Skate USA® Instructor Compliance. All compliance requirements must be met at the time of check-in to access the competition, with no exceptions.

Coaches of foreign athletes: If you are a coach of a foreign athlete only, you are not subject to Barbados Ice Skating Association coach compliance and will only be asked to provide a letter of good standing for the federation your athlete represents.
