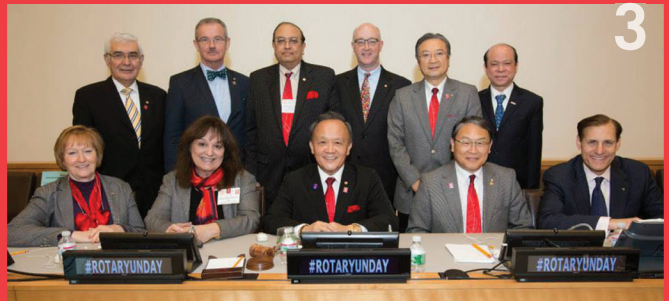


## PRESIDENT'S TRAVELS

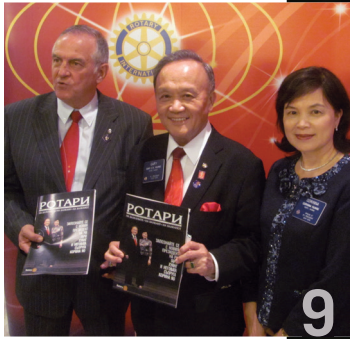
