One day I had him outside his fenced area when I heard a truck rumbling toward our property. I panicked thinking he would chase the truck and possibly get hit. His response was to dart back inside the gate so he could chase the truck BEHIND the safety of his fence. A great lesson to be learned is that God gives us boundaries that are there for our own good! If we violate them, there are consequences.
