All Games are played on Monday's: 6:00 – 7:30 pm

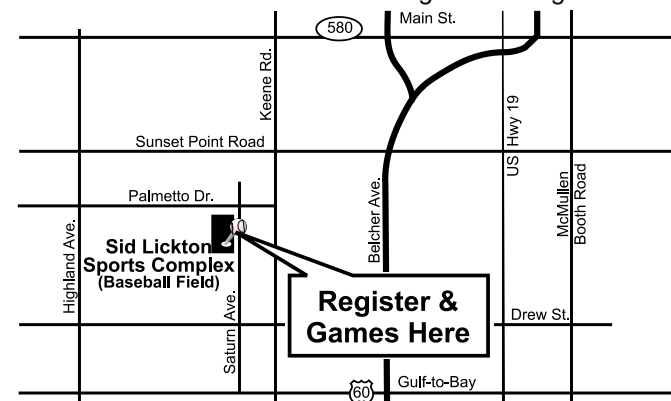
