Accelerating Ohio's Auto Industry Bill

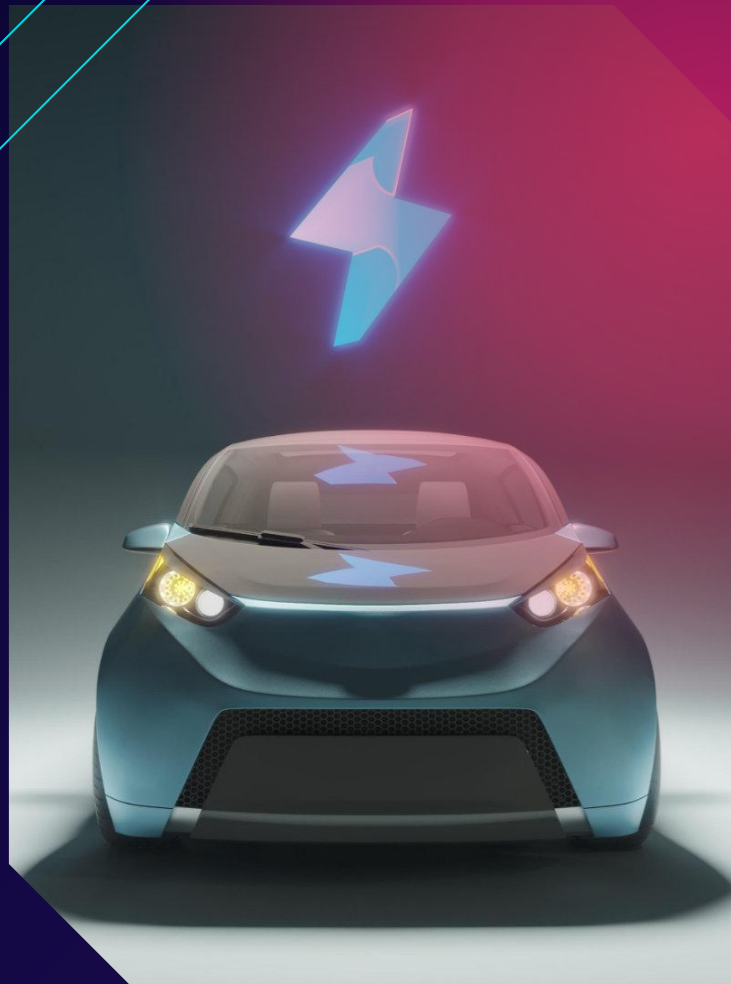
Announced officially on February 16th by Senator Rulli (R-33rd):

1. Factory Retooling and Workforce Development Investment
 - a. Factory Retooling: \$15,000,000 in grant funding to incentivize transition to EV facilities.
 - b. Funding for Automotive Technician and Electrician Educational Programs: \$10,000,000 in grant funding for programs that train auto technicians and electricians with a focused on EVs and charging infrastructure. Funds for curriculum, faculty training, training equipment, and tuition assistance
2. EV Purchase Incentives
 - a. Fleet and Consumer Incentives: Incentives in the form of a sales tax exemption - up to \$2,000 for all-electric, \$1,000 for PHEV, and \$1,000 for used all-electric vehicles
 - b. MSRP Caps: Base model MSRP below \$55,000 for sedans and below \$80,000 for vans, pickup trucks, and SUVs
3. State Task Force and Electrification Plan
 - a. Task Force Mission: Monitor and provide expertise on the EV market
 - b. State Electrification Plan: Outline how Ohio should lead in EV production and adoption. the template.
4. Updates to Utility EV Charging Infrastructure Regulations
 - a. Regulatory Certainty: Guidance for PUCO to provide regulatory certainty to Ohio's utilities and relieves individual site hosts of burdensome system upgrade costs.
 - b. Unlocking Investment: Utilities can support infrastructure for EV charging through incentives and investments.
