

RULES

Welcome to OctoBall, a fun and easy-to-play game that's perfect for players of all ages!

SET UP

- 1. Set up the OctoBall hoop by clicking all the pieces together. Connect it to the tripod base
- 2. Adjust the height to suit your taste and skill level a good rule of thumb is to set the ring at the shortest player's chin height, or wherever the group prefers.
- 3. Use a game of chance (like a coin toss) to determine who serves first
- 4. After game starts, the winner of the previous round serves first



GAME PLAY


- 1. Serve underhand from behind the 5-foot line.
- 2. Teams/players may hit the ball up to 3 times before returning it toward the hoop.
- 3. If the ball hits the hoop and rebounds back, that team is awarded 3 more hits.
- 4. If a team uses more than their allowed hits, the opposing team scores a point and serve next.
- 5. If the ball hits the ground, the opposing team scores a point.

WINNING

- 1. Games are 3 rounds typically played to 7 or more points (or any odd number).
- 2. You must win by rounds by 2 points. Best 2 out of 3.

PENALTIES

No Blocking the ring
No shots closer than 3 feet from the hoop
If your body touches or knocks the ring the opponent gets a point
No "Schwacking" (hitting the ball aggressively). If a player schwacks the ball, the non-schwacking team is awarded a point. Play with finesse and control.



⚠ WARNING:

CHOKING HAZARD -- Children under 8 yrs can choke or suffocate on uninflated or broken balloons. Adult supervision required. Keep uninflated balloons from children. Discard broken balloons at once.
