RANCH RULES ACCEPTANCE FORM

- 1. ATV's/UTV's are allowed, but <u>NO</u> driving off of designated roads except only to retrieve downed game. One vehicle or ATV/UTV is allowed on the mountain for your hunt. So, we hope you bring people with you on your hunt but we ask that your group fit into one vehicle.
- 2. All game laws must be strictly complied with, including but not limited to tagging of animals, care of meat, hunting from roads or vehicles etc. Hunters and non-hunting companions must familiarize themselves with State, Federal, Ranch and local game laws.
- 3. <u>Hunters may only hunt for, shoot from and shoot at animals within the boundaries of the Cooperative Wildlife Management Unit.</u> All hunters and non-hunting companions are responsible for familiarizing themselves with the boundaries.
- 4. Access to cooperative wildlife management unit does not include or permit access to adjoining private land.
- 5. Absolutely no open fires on the CWMU.
- 6. Absolutely no shooting any other animals or creatures on the cooperative wildlife management unit.
- 7. Hunters will coordinate hunting times and camping areas with the Cooperative Wildlife Management Unit Operator. (Gary Webb, 801-836-8411).
- 8. All hunters and non-hunting companions will not disturb land owners cattle, horses, sheep or livestock of any kind and shut all gates that are shut and lock all gates that are locked as you pass through
- 9. Contact the operator for suggested areas to camp.
