Vision: Develop an educational system for the Tubman-Gray School to ensure all its students achieve the highest academic standard in the country and that the system becomes the model for education in the Republic of Liberia.

Mission: Develop and implement the *Eagle's Wings Program*, a robust and high quality educational system in grades 1-3 as a foundation

Strategy: The *Eagle's Wings Program* will focus on curriculum development/enhancement, teacher recruitment and training, student financial assistance, essential educational tools, supplementing teacher salaries, best practice teaching strategies, and creating a safe, healthy and supportive learning environment.

The Eagle's Wings Initiative

Financial Management

- Funds will be transferred to the school via Western Union
- School will issue receipts acknowledging receipt of funds
- School will also issue receipts for everything the funds are used for, books, financial aid etc.

Financial Aid

- Financial aid will be granted to first graders
- No financial aid will be given to relatives of employees at the school
- Students will go through a screening and then an evaluation process to be selected
- \$1950 has been awarded in financial aid, targeted for 17 students under the anticipation that the school will have 8 students paying full tuition; bringing the total to 25 students in the classroom
- The school will determine how much financial aid a student will get based on information they gather on parents' ability to pay and academic achievements
- Intent is for parents to pay some of the fees in order to have a stake in their childs education. However, there may be mitigating circumstances where some students may receive 100% support based on academics and parents financial standing.
- The school will give us names, photos, registration forms, payment receipts of all students given financial aid

□ First Grade Selection Process

- Screening-Limited analysis of their ability to write, spell, identify colors and other things they should have learned in
- Assessment
 - Writing and reciting capital and small letters
 - Writing and saying their names
 - Writing two letters words (So, go, Lo, No, etc.)
 - Writing and reciting the numbers from 1 to 100
